FLEECE AND WOOL COMPETITION DETAILS

1. Entry Fee: \$5.00 per fleece - @ \$2.00 per skein of wool
2. Maximum of two entries per class
3. Deadline for entry forms: August 21, 2009
4. Fleeces should be in the grease, clean and well skirted/prepared. Entries are “raw fiber” as collected from the source. Fiber that has been washed, combed or brushed after harvest will not be accepted.
5. Fleece must be from animals owned by the exhibitor and must be no more than 15 months growth
6. White and natural colored fleeces may be entered. Where entries warrant, classes may be divided and judged as white or colored.
7. Entire skeins of wool must be entered, samples will not be accepted
8. The judge and/or committee reserve the right to move fleeces and/or wool to the appropriate class, or combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
9. The decision of the judge will be final

- CLASS 3** **SPECIALTY WOOL FLEECE** Including Icelandic, Shetland, Jacob, Karakul,
Scottish Blackface
- CLASS 4** **CROSSBRED FLEECE** Specify breed combination
- CHAMPION AND RESERVE FLEECE**
- CLASS 5** **Skein; single ply** – 100% wool fiber
- CLASS 6** **Skein; 2 ply** – 100% wool fiber
- CLASS 7** **Novelty Blend;** must be 50% wool content, may include other fibres/techniques
- CLASS 8** **Home Grown Fiber;** spun wool from animals owned by participant
- CLASS 9** **Youth;** Spun by youth 18 and under, mark age on entry
