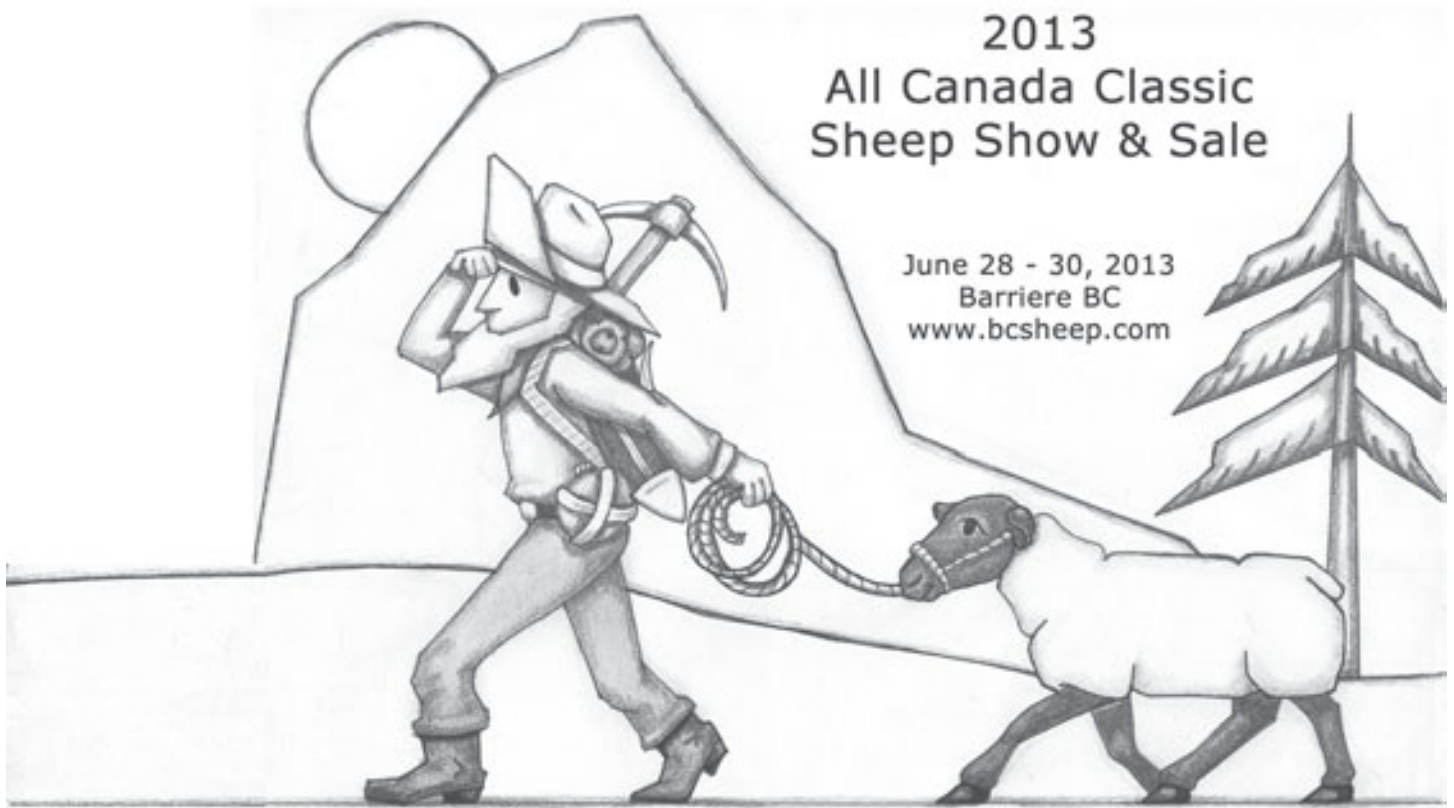

# 2012 Classic Sale - Terms & Conditions

## ORDER OF SALE:

- 1) Breeds will sell in the order listed in the show catalogue (alphabetical)
- 2) Within each breed, the order will be Champion Ewe, yearling ewes, senior ewe lambs, junior ewe lambs, Champion Ram, yearling rams, senior ram lambs, junior ram lambs.
- 3) Within each class, animals will be sold by the order of their placing in the show.

**HEALTH and SOUNDNESS:** All animals will be rigidly culled by the culling committee and the attending veterinarian. The sale committee is authorized to settle disputes and interpret the rules. Their decision is final.

**REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES:** Registration certificates must be submitted to the sales office upon arrival at the Classic, and signed on the back for transfer. This applies to all entries, including junior lambs. The CSBA office will process transfers and the cost will be deducted from the sale settlement.

**COMMISSION:** Sale commission is 15%. The minimum commission on animals that sell will be \$30 and the maximum commission on animals that sell will be \$150.

**BUYERS:** Buyers must obtain a buyer's number from the sale clerk. Buyers will please indicate exactly how each animal is to be registered. Please provide your full name, address, telephone number and email address.

**TERMS:** Payment may be made by cash, personal cheque, debit card, Visa or Mastercard.

**GUARANTEE:** Each consignor guarantees right and title to all animals sold. Unless otherwise noted in the sale catalogue or announced from the auction stand, each animal is sold as being sound in accordance with the culling committee inspections.

All animals are guaranteed breeders if properly handled. Any settlement of such guarantee is between the consignor and purchaser and is limited as to the restrictions stated below. The Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association and Purebred Sheep Breeders' Association of Nova Scotia assume no responsibility, expressed or implied, in this guarantee.

**ALL MALES** are guaranteed as breeders by the time they are seven months of age, subject to marking harness observation. Should any ram fail to prove to be a breeder, a satisfactory settlement shall be deemed to be replacement

with another of equal value and quality, or refund of purchase price, with the buyer having the choice.

**ALL FEMALES** are guaranteed breeders. Should any female 12 months of age or older, not pregnant at the time of sale, fail to become pregnant during the 2012 breeding season, the purchaser has the right to claim adjustment in writing to the seller within 12 months of the sale. Should any female younger than 12 months of age and not pregnant at the time of sale, fail to become pregnant during the 2012 breeding season, the purchaser should notify the seller within 12 months of the sale, but wait to see if the ewe again fails to become pregnant during the 2013 breeding season, before claiming adjustment in writing to the seller within 24 months of the sale. Satisfactory settlement shall be deemed to be replacement of another ewe of equal value and health status, or refund of purchase price less 15%. No incidental expenses, such as feed, care, etc. will be charged by either party when making settlement. All transportation charges on animals returned to a seller or to a purchaser are the account of the shipper.

Exposed ewes of any age, even if marked prior to sale, are not guaranteed to be pregnant or produce living lambs.

**RISK/REMOVAL:** All animals are at purchaser's risk as soon as sold. Delivery must be taken at conclusion of sale. All animals must be removed from the barn by 12pm on Sunday, June 17, 2012.

**ERRORS:** If any errors are noted, corrections will be made from the auction stand. All announcements at sale time, written or oral, supersede any material written in this catalogue. A board to list changes will be available at the information desk.

**LIABILITY:** The Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association, the Purebred Sheep Breeders' Association of Nova Scotia and their directors, owners and employees accept no liability that may occur. Accidents at sheep sales are very rare, but all attending must do so at their own risk.

# Vente Classique 2012 – Modalités & Conditions

## ORDRE DE VENTE:

- 1) Les animaux seront vendus selon l'ordre de race présenté dans le catalogue (ordre alphabétique);
- 2) Dans une même race l'ordre sera comme suit: Grande championne, brebis d'un an, agnelles senior, agnelles junior, Grand champion, béliers d'un an, agneaux senior, agneaux junior;
- 3) Dans chaque classe d'âge les animaux seront vendus selon l'ordre de position qu'ils ont obtenus dans le jugement.

**SANTÉ:** Tous les animaux seront rigoureusement examinés et, au besoin, retirés de la vente par le comité de vérification de la Classique et le vétérinaire attitré. Le comité de vérification de la de vente de la Classique a l'autorisation de régler des disputes et peut interpréter les règlements. La décision de ce comité est finale.

**CERTIFICATS D'ENREGISTREMENT:** Les certificats d'enregistrement devront être signés pour le transfert et soumis au bureau de vente de la Classique dès l'arrivée des éleveurs sur le site. Advenant qu'une femelle de plus de 12 mois, non gestante au moment de la vente et qui ne le devient pas lors de la saison d'accouplement 2012, alors l'acheteur a le droit de faire une réclamation par écrit au vendeur dans les douze mois suivant la vente. Advenant qu'une femelle de moins de 12 mois, non gestante lors de la vente et qui ne le devient pas lors de la saison d'accouplement 2012, alors l'acheteur devrait avertir le vendeur de cette situation dans les douze mois suivant la vente, mais attendre de voir si la femelle sera gestante lors de la saison d'accouplement 2013, et ce, avant de faire une réclamation par écrit au vendeur dans les vingt-quatre mois suivant la vente. Le règlement devra être le remplacement de l'animal par une autre femelle de même valeur et de la même qualité ou par le remboursement du prix de la vente moins 15 %. 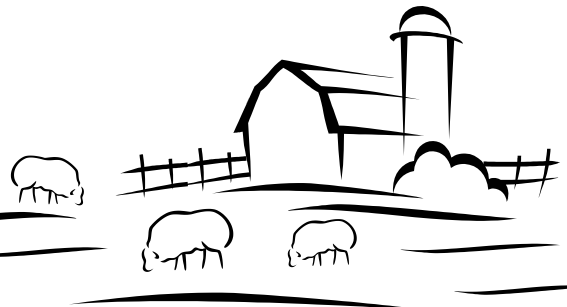

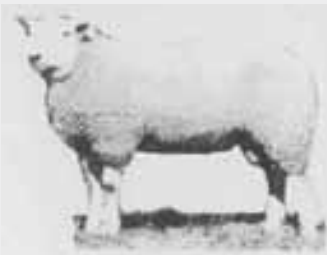

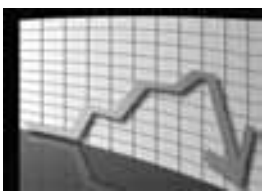
# What Benefits Could Bring Me?!

## Genetic selection helps to increase the productivity of your ewes

Genetic evaluation may help you to select for more productive animals in your flock. A little difference in genetic value can result in a big difference in your overall productivity. For example, an **EPD of +0.1 for number of lambs born** means that the progeny of that animal will have 0.1 more lambs than the progeny of an animal with an EPD of 0. If the average is 1.9 lambs born then the progeny of an animal with a +0.1 for number of lambs born will on average have 2.0 lambs. To put this in dollars and cents, if 400 ewes had the genetic capability to produce +0.1 more lambs, 40 more lambs would theoretically be produced by them resulting in **an extra \$5600**, assuming a market value of \$140 per lamb.



## GenOvis helps to detect unproductive ewes



Unproductive ewes cost you a lot of money throughout the year. The GenOvis program has many reports that may help you to identify the unproductive ewes and cull them quickly. The average of kg weaned per ewe per year is a good indication of which ewes are the more productive. By looking at the average of your flock, it is easy to find the ewes that are less productive than the rest of the flock given the same management.

Whether you have a commercial or a registered flock, identifying those ewes who are significantly below your flocks average **will help you to cull unproductive ewes, resulting in increased flock productivity.**

**Commercial and Registered producers alike will benefit from using the information generated by the GenOvis program to manage their ewes. Identifying and culling unproductive and poorly performing ewes is the first step towards improving flock profits.**

Once you know who the slackers are, why would you keep them? In the above example, the first three ewes are obviously not covering their maintenance costs or returning a profit to the operation and need to be culled. The GenOvis program allows you to work with your production report information in an Excel file. You will be able to sort the data according to the importance you attributed for each trait in your farm and to calculate the average of your own flock for each performance trait. The three ewes in red should definitely be culled, in anybody's flock.

### Producers keep records, GenOvis helps to turn that information into knowledge

The first step is to record the information needed by GenOvis to generate the information that you need to make informed culling decisions. Once you have the information provided by GenOvis it is easier to see if the performance of your flock is either improving, staying the same, or getting worse. You may not like what the reports tell you but at least you will know where you stand. Productivity data is essential to determine the actual performance of your flock. The GenOvis program is a tool that allows you to easily track the performance of your flock by using its flock evaluation report.



For example, a **decrease of only 0.05 lambs weaned per ewe per year** in your 400 ewes flock is really difficult to detect. This will also be more difficult if you don't keep your productivity records. In fact, this little decrease represents 20 lambs weaned less per year. If we estimate that all of these lambs would be sold at an average of \$140, this **would result in made \$2 800 less gross revenue** at the end of the year. That is only a change of one half of one percent and look at the opportunity for profit! **Having access to performance records through the GenOvis program may help you to detect this situation quickly and respond.**

### GenOvis helps to identify profitable sire lines

For example, if you use a ram as a herdsire that has progeny and his EPDs are lower than the average of the breed, this means that the progeny of this ram may have a lower performance than the average of the breed. If you decided to use a ram that has breeding values below the average of the breed you would expect that his



progeny will have also have lower performance than the average of the breed. **The GenOvis program provides you with the performance information that you need to select rams that are at least above average for their breed for performance. The more progeny information that a ram has available for evaluation, the more reliable the results are and the more you can count on the genetic benefit of a particular sireline.**

GenOvis is a good tool to help you to monitor and manage the performance of your flock. You cannot manage what you do not measure. The choice is yours, leave the performance of your flock up to chance or depend on measures of performance on which to base your management decisions on. 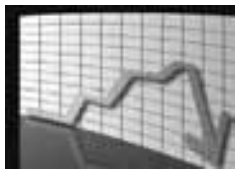
# Quels bénéfices GenOvis peut-il m'apporter?

## La sélection génétique aide à améliorer la productivité de vos brebis

L'évaluation génétique peut vous aider à sélectionner les animaux les plus productifs de votre troupeau. Une petite différence au niveau de la valeur génétique d'un animal peut résulter en une grosse différence au niveau de votre production annuelle. 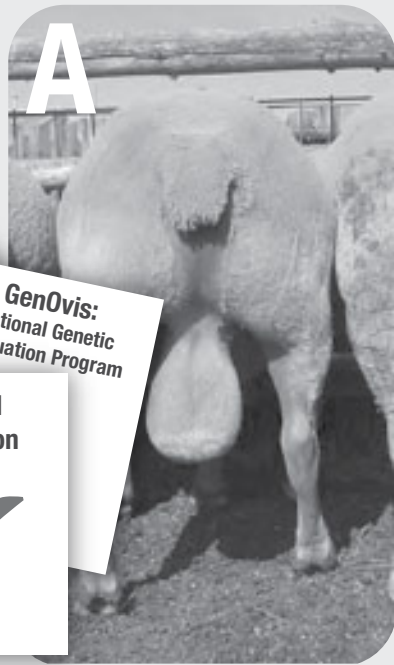
